Electoral Commission Queensland (ECQ) continues to advise that the local government elections will go ahead this Saturday, 28 March 2020

The Department of Local Government, Racing and Multicultural Affairs is asking councils to help ECQ share the message that the elections are compulsory and there are voting options available.

Please promote the below key messages through your extensive community networks (social media, websites etc).

The Electoral Commission of Queensland wants everyone to feel at ease about voting in the 2020 local government elections.

You can:

- Bring your own pen or pencil
- Stay 1.5 metres apart
- Use hand sanitiser

Voting in elections is compulsory, so make sure you have your say.

There will be staff on hand at polling booths to assist and ensure all public health measures are in place.

Vote today at an early voting location, on Saturday 28 March between 8am and 6pm or for those considered vulnerable to COVID-19 or who are self-isolating, voting can be arranged via an electronically assisted voting option.
