*Statutory Bodies Financial Arrangements Act 1982***GENERAL APPROVAL UNDER PART 9 DIVISION 2****Approval**

1. Pursuant to sections 60A and 70 of the SBFA Act, I grant a general approval for all statutory bodies to enter into type 1 financial arrangements, being the provision of an Indemnity.

Effective Date and Expiry

2. This general approval will be effective from the date it is gazetted in accordance with section 70(1) of the SBFA Act.

Revoke previous approvals

3. This approval revokes all other approvals granted under Part 9 of the SBFA Act to the extent they relate to the provision of an Indemnity from the effective date.

Delegation

4. The power to grant this approval is exercised pursuant to the delegation to the Under Treasurer executed by the then Deputy Premier, Treasurer and Minister for State Development, Trade and Innovation under section 76(2) of the SBFA Act on 23 March 2006.

Definitions

5. For the purposes of this approval, the following definitions apply:
 - words and phrases in this approval have the same meaning as in the SBFA Act;
 - 'Arrangement' includes an agreement, deed or undertaking;
 - 'Indemnity' means an indemnity in an arrangement entered into for the purpose of undertaking activities associated with discharging its statutory functions; and
 - "SBFA Act" means the *Statutory Bodies Financial Arrangements Act 1982*.
